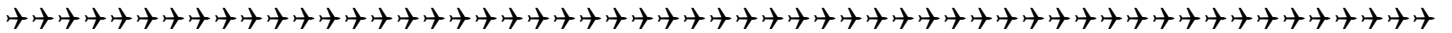

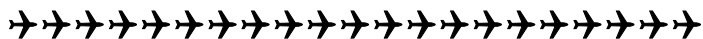

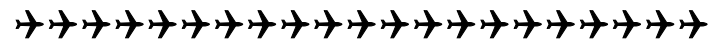
There was no Treasurer's Report.

From the President -

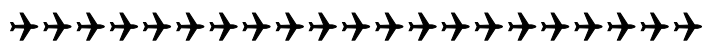
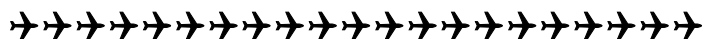

Tips and Tricks.



One-inch long, 2-56 machine screws are generally found in hardware or radio parts stores, and with the head removed and the end cleaned up with a file, they make useful threaded ends for nylon pushrods such as Sullivan Gold-N-Rods. *Randy Randolph, Dallas, TX.*



A sheet metal screw of the appropriate size, soldered to an old screwdriver, works admirably for marking and prethreading servo mount holes. Much easier than fumbling in the depths of the fuselage with a screw and a screwdriver. *Lance Skoreyko, Ft. St. John, Canada.*

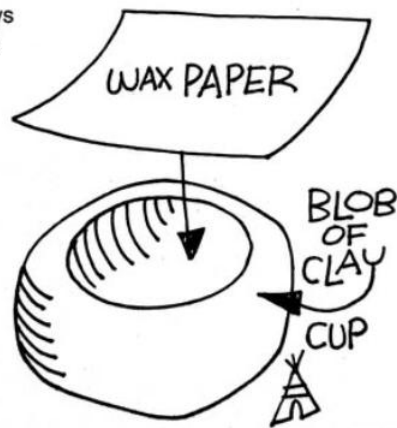


Setting the lengths of pushrods often calls for extra hands to hold the control surface at neutral while rods are being measured. This simple control clamp made from strip to fit firmly over the surface will do the holding nicely. Controls made from tapered trailing edge stock need to be shimmed to keep them central with this clamp, or you could make a special one to fit. *Douglas Allen, Parma, OH.*

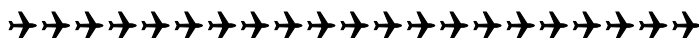
TONY'S TIPS

This Cup Won't Spilleth Over:

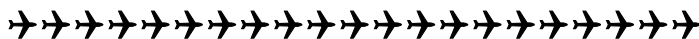
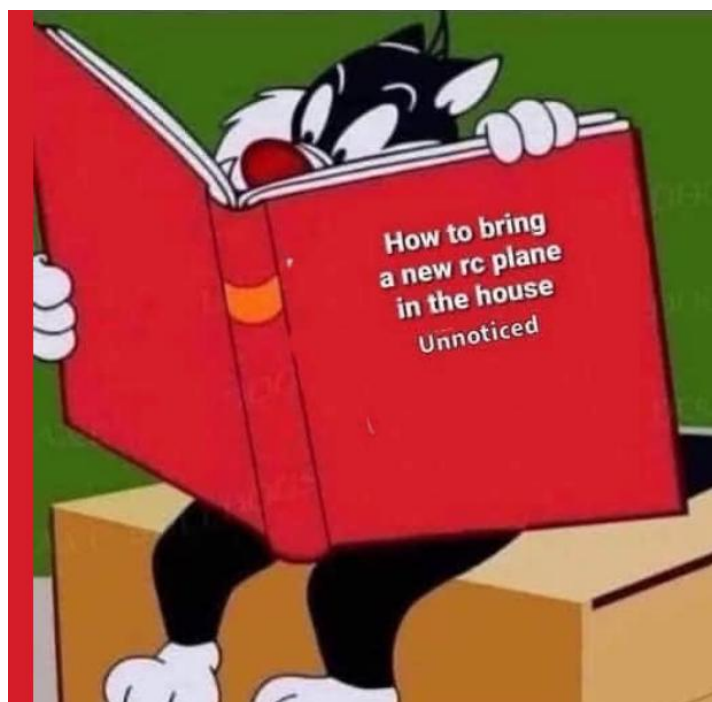
Tom Arnold makes a little glue pot for CyA by smushing a depression into a blob of clay, and lining it with a bit of wax paper. He uses a toothpick to apply small amounts of CyA, and says it take a long time before the little pool of CyA sets.
